James Audubon in 1831, who described
its forceful yet modest waters. Today, as
a protected state park, De Leon Springs
preserves Audubon's observations.







GRETO HOME

Between the surf of the East Coast and the white sand beaches of the Gulf, it's no secret that Florida has outstanding golf. The First Coast is no exception and – if truth be told – North Florida is often underrated. Once you visit the outstanding resorts, such as Hammock Beach, TPC Sawgrass, and World Golf Village, you'll understand why more people are flocking to this hidden treasure for vacation and permanent residency. In particular, World Golf Village (WGV) sits in the beautiful coastal region between the Atlantic Ocean and the St. Johns River in the nation's oldest city of St. Augustine. WGV is home to two championship courses, King & Bear and Slammer & Squire.



"The King and Bear is a great course for a beginner with big greens and a wide open field. Just play from the front tees. You'll never regret taking on this hobby. as it will change your life. I love the game even if I am playing poorly." – Eric B.

The King & Bear is named after its designers, Arnold Palmer (The King) and Jack Nicklaus (The Bear). It is the first and only collaboration between the two legendary golfers. Combining the two contrasting styles creates a challenging and fun experience for golfers of all skill levels. In June 2020, King & Bear was the host of the Korn Ferry Tour King & Bear Classic, where Kris Kirk was crowned champion after shooting twenty-six under for the tournament.

Just a mile down the road sits The Slammer & Squire, which is in the heart of the WGV resort corridor. This championship course was designed by Hall of Fame members Sam "The Slammer" Snead and Gene "The Squire" Sarazen, with the help of

well-known golf course architect Bobby Weed. The three of them shared a desire to design and build a golf course that rewards good shot-making while maintaining the Florida property's natural beauty. This resort course is wide open with only a few water hazards and some well-undulated greens. Like the two legends who helped create this course, the layout emphasizes the short game, requiring several finesse shots.

The Sunshine State holds its own as a golfing mecca — and North Florida continues with the charge. With beaches, golf, fantastic restaurants and historical sites, whether you're coming here for a vacation or looking for your next home, there is plenty to do on and off the course.
